**EXPRESSION OF INTEREST (EOI) FOR ENGAGING RELEVANT ENTITIES AND
EXPERTS FOR IMPLEMENTATION AND RESEARCH ON ISSUES OF CHILD RIGHTS
AND CHILD PROTECTION**

1. Background

1.1. The State Commission for Protection of Child Rights (SCPCR) was set up under the Commission for Protection of Child Rights Act, 2005, an Act of Parliament (December 2005). The Commission's Mandate is to ensure that all Laws, Policies, Programs, and Administrative Mechanisms are in consonance with the Child Rights perspective as enshrined in the Constitution of India and also the UN Convention on the Rights of the Child. The Child is defined as a person in the 0 to 18 years age group.

1.2. SCPCR's key objectives of for proposed engagement are :

- a) Conduct a comprehensive need assessment in each district, on child protection by establishing the nature and magnitude of the gaps in knowledge, skills, aptitudes and attitudes of the existing child protection services in each District of Uttarakhand.
- b) Examine and review the safeguards provided by or under any law for the time being in force for the protection of child rights and recommend measures for their effective implementation.
- c) Examine all factors that inhibit the enjoyment of rights of children affected by terrorism, communal violence, riots, natural disaster, domestic violence, HIV/AIDS, trafficking, maltreatment, torture and exploitation, pornography and prostitution and recommend appropriate remedial measures.
- d) Look into the matters relating to children in need of special care and protection including children in distress, marginalized and disadvantaged children, children in conflict with law, juveniles, children without family and children of prisoners and recommend appropriate remedial measures.

- e) Spread child rights literacy among various sections of the society and promote awareness of the safeguards available for protection of these rights through publications, the media, seminars and other available means;
- f) Undertake and promote research in the field of child rights
- g) Determine the measures required to bridge the identified gaps, which may include, but not limited to, recommendation of the required service delivery mechanism, structures, required expertise, the level of training, training institutions, etc

2. Proposed Engagement of Relevant Entities

2.1. SCPCR invites relevant entities ("The Applicant") working in the field of

Child Rights Protection to assist SCPCR in achievement of its objectives and mandates

- a) The Applicant should be an entity, individual or institute or organization registered as Firm/Society/Trust/NGO/Company in India and in existence for the last 5 years or more in India. The Applicant shall submit relevant certificate of incorporation along with the Application.
- b) The applicant should have past 5 years experience of program implementation or research on issues of Child Rights and Child Protection.
- c) The Applicant should have relevant experience of at least 3 years in the specific field of engagement

2.2. SCPCR envisages the engagement of agencies in following specific fields of engagement:

- a) Organizing or Assisting SCPCR in organizing State Level and District Level workshops for various aspects of Child Rights and Child Protection and related acts.
- b) Undertaking Research on implementation & impact of Child Rights and Child Protection Activities and all related acts.

- c) Undertaking various research, surveys & studies for key mandates and objectives mentioned at 1.2

3. Process of Application :

3.1. Applicants must submit their details, experience information and interest in specific field of engagement at SCPCR website under NGO Corner option (URL : <http://scpcruk.org.in/NGOCorner.aspx>)

3.2. SCPCR shall screen the applications based on relevant experience and invite shortlisted Applicants for detailed presentation and proposal submission. SCPCR may, in exceptional circumstances, and at its sole discretion, extend the Application Due Date by issuing an Addendum uniformly for all Applicants.

4. Last Date of Submission:

- 4.1. Applications should be submitted before 1400 hours IST on 26-03-2016.
4.2. Any Application received after the Application Due Date and time shall not be accepted by SCPCR. Any such Application received after the Application Due Date shall be summarily rejected and returned unopened.
